



PROTOCOL FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 4-2016, passed by the City Council of the City of Effingham on January 5, 2016, the protocol for public participation at Council Meetings is as follows:

Public participation

- 1. Citizens attending the Council meeting shall be allowed to address the Council after being acknowledged by the Mayor.**
 - 2. Citizens desiring to address the Council are required to complete a speaker's card that indicates the name of the speaker, identifies the topic(s) of discussion, and describes any action that the citizen wants the Council to consider concerning the topic(s) of choice.**
 - 3. The speaker's card must be submitted prior to ten (10) minutes before the scheduled meeting is to begin.**
 - 4. There is a five (5) minute time limit per speaker.**
